Aloha Gardens is a water and wastewater system. The water treatment plant is located at 3546 Darlington Road, Holiday, Florida. At Aloha Gardens, the FGUA serves approximately 3,100 water customers and 2,810 wastewater customers.

Water System Summary

The Aloha Gardens plant treatment capacity is permitted for 123,000 GPD on an average annual daily flow (AADF) basis. The water treatment plant is a Category IV Class C facility.

- One (1) public potable water supply well
- One (1) 20 HP Submersible well pump
- One (1) Hydro-pneumatic tank 6,000 gallons

- Forty (40) Fire Hydrants
- Three (3) Interconnections to Pasco County Utilities
 - Interconnect # 1 is at 3700 Gulf Trace
 - Interconnect # 2 is at 4348 Plaza Drive
 - Emergency interconnect # 3 is at 4849 Plaza Drive

ALOHA GARDENS Water distribution system

Approximately 124,470 LF of pipe in the entire system comprising of:

- 37,010 LF of 8 inch pipe
- 13,263 LF of 6 inch pipe
- 29,777 LF of 4 inch pipe
- 19,415 LF of 3 inch pipe
- 25,005 LF of 2 inch pipe

ALOHA GARDEN Wastewater System Components

Lift Station # 12 interconnects the wastewater system to Pasco County Utilities for treatment.

ALOHA GARDENS Wastewater Collection system

Collection system consists of approximately the following:

- Twelve (12) Lift Stations, including two (2) within Tahitian Gardens
- Five hundred and Forty (540) Manholes
- Twenty four (24) Sewage submersible pumps, two (2) at each Lift Station
- Four (4) SCADA systems at Lift Stations
- 82,660 LF of 8 Inch Gravity Mains
- 16,870 LF of Force Mains
