
MORNING VIEW SERVICE AREA



Morning View is located approximately 2.5 miles South of Leesburg off SR 27 (CR33) approximately 700 feet East of SR 27, along the western shore of Lake Harris. The FGUA provides water service to approximately 36 customers and wastewater services to approximately 37 customers.

Water System Summary

The water system has one water treatment facility. This is a Category V Class C Facility with a permitted capacity of 13,425 Gallons per Day. The facility has one raw water submersible well pump which pumps water after it is treated with liquid chlorine to a 5,000 gallon hydropneumatics (HPN) tank.

Water System Components

Distribution system—

- 3,773 LF of water mains
- 2 Hydrants

Wastewater System Summary

The wastewater treatment facility is a Category III, Class D Facility with a permitted capacity of 20,000 Gallons per Day based on Annual Average Daily Flows (AADF) it is an extended aeration treatment facility regulated by FDEP number FLA010610.

Wastewater System Components

Plant infrastructure includes—

- Two aeration basins
- One Clarifier
- One Digester
- One Chlorine Contact Chamber
- Two Blowers
- Liquid Chlorination to disinfect

Components include -

- 2,101 LF of p mains
- 2,856 gravity mains
- 3 Lift stations
- 12 manholes

Effluent disposal

The FDEP has authorized to discharge treated effluent to be discharged into an existing rapid infiltration basin. The plant has a 22,500 square foot infiltration basin for the reuse water.
